Aviation Class 1 Medical
Hold an Aviation Security Identification Card (ASIC)
Minimum of 18 years of age for CPL flight test
Hold or be eligible to hold an Aeronautical Radio Operator Certificate
Obtain a Unique Student Identifier Number (USI) prior to enrolment
Completed year 12 with passing grades in Math and English or successful completion at the required level of the Basic Key Skills Builder (BKSB) assessment through Airwork Aviation
Meet Airwork Aviation's entry requirements and VET student loans requirements (if applying for VET Student Loan)

***Third and subsequent attempts for exams, flight tests and flight training are an additional student expense and are not covered by tuition fees.**

Vet Student Loan is an interest-free personal loan from the Australian Government that provides eligible students access to capped funding to help pay for their studies. A "gap" payment may be required to make up the difference. Based on a loan fee of 20% being applied, the VSL debt total a student may incur if the student receives the maximum VSL referred to above is \$98,400.00. Your loan is repaid through the Australian tax system when you reach the minimum income threshold, which is set each year by the Australian Government and published on Study assist.
